Project Summary

Block 38 Section 34 Narrabundah Wetlands

a) On-ground works engaged volunteers through site preparation, planting of new tube stock, to improve water retention, reduce discharge of sediment into the stormwater drains and nearby creek and ultimately improve the area by adding additional habitat for native wildlife and creating human and nature connectivity.

b) Systematic weed control took place of blackberry, poplar, wattle, fleabane and pyracantha, using volunteers where possible, TCCS for removal of smaller Box Elders and contractors where use of machinery and herbicides for larger woody weed removal.

c) Community were connected through involvement in these project activities with innovative

educational workshops through habitat for wildlife, healthy waterways and weed Identification. This not only improved the community's understanding about the areas conservation value, but also showed them how to maintain it.

d) Ongoing weekly maintenance for weeding and watering by volunteers.

e) Rubbish removal through Cleanup days.
