The Friends of Ainslie Volcanics Grasslands are currently undertaking restoration work on their site to improve the conservation values of the Natural Temperate Grasslands and Woody Grasslands, having received funding support in the 2023-2024 Environment Grants. This application is for follow up costs that were identified in the GrassRoots Environmental Ecological Restoration Site Plan (2023) that was completed through the Environment Grant. The plan outlines some priorities that need to be addressed to accompany the restoration works already underway. These items include:

- The removal of an old fence line that inhibits the movement of species and poses a risk to landcarers. This can be done through a contractor or by the group with adequate tools to allow safe removal.
- Better support for the tube stock from rabbits that are uncontrolled onsite with mulch and pest control.
- The establishment of monitoring points for long term assessment across the site by way of installing visible survey markers.
- Accessing a source of water for the upcoming plantings in 2024 by means of a water cube positioned on site.

The overarching aim of restoration activities on this site is to protect and improve the ecological function of this important NTG and Grassy Woodland area, and to improve habitat connectivity for woodland birds, small to medium mammals, insect pollinators and grassland reptiles. An additional aim is to enhance community amenity and provide opportunities for connection to nature, traditional land management and volunteering.

#### **Please justify how your project will meet the assessment criteria.**

This proposed project complements existing Government and community efforts and align with the intended outcomes of the Adopt-A-Park program. Prior to urban development, the broader area was historically Box Gum Grassy Woodland and Natural Temperate Grasslands, both of which are listed as Endangered Ecological Communities under Federal and State legislation. The Ainslie Volcanics site contains important remnants of both of these communities which are connected to other areas of important vegetation on Mount Ainslie (and foothills). The overall diversity of vegetation at the Ainslie Volcanics site is very high with several patches of very high conservation value woodlands and grasslands due to this diversity. With this in mind, the conservation efforts being made at this site are of significance and demonstrates capacity for both short-term and long-term benefits for larger connectivity objectives.
